- You must write complete sentences when answering questions.



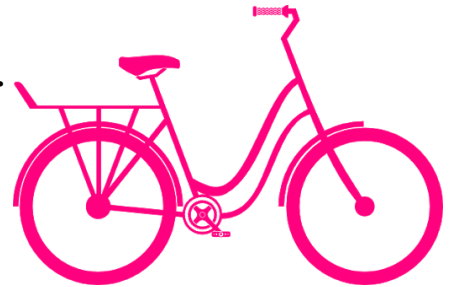
INSTRUCTIONS: Read the short story three (3) times. Answer the questions that follow.

ANSWER KEY

1. What is the colour of the bicycle?

The bicycle is bright pink. / The bicycle is pink.

2. From whom did Emma get the bicycle?

Emma got the bicycle from her uncle.

3. Where was the bicycle hidden?

It was hidden behind a bush.

4. What did Emma do when she saw the bicycle?

When Emma saw the bicycle, she jumped for joy and gave her uncle a big hug. / She jumped for joy and gave her uncle a big hug.

5. How does Emma feel about her uncle?

Emma loves her uncle. / She loves her uncle.
